Then you'll hear the third of our three soloists for this year, Wolcott Humphrey, performing Artie Shaw's exciting *Concerto for Clarinet*. The first half of the concert will close with another premiere, Buckley's brand-new transcription of movements from Bizet's *Carmen Suites 1 and 2*. We will, as always, welcome MetWinds teachers' students to join us for the second half of the program. The middle school students will play Hugh Stewart's *Three Ayres from Gloucester*, styled after early English folk music, and John Mackey's *Lightning Field*. Finally, the high school students will join us for Buckley's comprehensive and exciting arrangement of nearly all of the music from Meredith Willson's famed Broadway show, *The Music Man*.
